BRUT translates to dry/raw and these two elements knit the cornerstone that informs our process. Salt from the Salish Sea and the passing of time in controlled conditions slowly concentrate the flavours found in our dried sausages and salami. With some products aging up to a year or more, dry curing is a curiosity that is uncommon (unfortunately) among most producers of specialty delicatessen in this country. We nod heavily to the Mediterranean traditions of France, Spain and Italy as that is where we've been lucky

enough to pass time- but make no mistake. This is a foundation, a point jumping off into the yet unknown.
